## Curriculum Newsletter—Term 4

### Reading

This term, Grade 1s and 2s will be learning about:

- Different strategies they can use to improve reading and comprehension including re-reading, substitution and inferring
- Distinguishing between important information and interesting information in an information text.
- The purpose and features of different types of poetry.

### Writing

- How to write a persuasive letter inclusive of strong persuasive language.
- Different strategies for spelling words with regular and irregular spelling patterns.
- How to revise and edit their writing in order to make improvements.

### Speaking and Listening

- How to engage in formal and informal discussions with others, demonstrating appropriate listening and speaking skills.
- What an opinion is and how to express them using more assertive language.
- Listen for specific information and instructions.

### Number and Algebra

This term, Grade 1s and 2s will be learning about:

- How to make, name and record fractions, including halves, quarters and eighths.
- Naming and ordering Australian coins and notes according to their value.
- Counting small collections of coins to match the total on a price tag.

### Measurement and Geometry

- The language of location such as 'clock-wise', 'forward' and 'under'.
- How to give and follow directions to familiar locations.
- Interpreting simple maps of familiar locations and identifying key features located on the map.

### Statistics and Probability

- Identifying outcomes of familiar events involving chance.
- Describing the likelihood of an event occurring using appropriate language such as 'will happen', 'won't happen' and 'likely' or 'unlikely' to happen.

## Inquiry

This term, Grade 1s and 2s will be learning about:

- The observable changes in our environment.
- How the weather impacts how we behave and dress.
- How landscapes can have natural and man made features.
- How landscapes can change according to the time of day, week or year and the weather.
- How the weather impacts how we behave and dress.
- The weather can impact animals, including our pets.
- How we can explore natural, made, and managed features that undergo change.
- Daily, weekly and seasonal changes in the environment.

## Home Learning

Each fortnight students will be provided with a Home Learning task. To make the most of these learning experiences, these activities need to be completed with the assistance of family members. Students will receive their task on Monday and it will be collected at the end of the second week.

## Water Bottle & Brain Food

It is strongly recommended that your child brings a piece of fruit or vegetable as brain food. Students should also bring their own water bottle to ensure they stay hydrated throughout the day. Students usually have their brain food break at 10:00am.
