Key knowledge, skills and understandings students will be developing this term are:

Reading

In Reading we are learning to:

- * Solve words we don't know by looking at the first, middle and last letter.
- * Make sure our reading is fluent by stopping at full stops.
- * Predict what we think will happen in a book.

Writing

In Writing, we are learning to:

- * Write stories that have a beginning, middle and end.
- * Start a sentence with a capital letter and finish it with a full stop.
- * Use our coloured words in our writing.
- * Re-read our writing to make sure it makes sense.
- * Add more detail in our writing.

Speaking and Listening

In Speaking and Listening we are learning to:

- * use expression when talking.
- * ask our friends a question if we don't understand.

Number and Algebra

In Number and Algebra, we are learning to:

- * Add numbers using different strategies, e.g. counting on from the biggest number.
- * Subtract numbers using different strategies, e.g. counting back using a number line.
- * Evenly share objects between a group of people
- * Skip count by 5s and 10s up to 100.

Money

In Money, we are learning to:

- * Identify Australian coins and notes.
- * Understand the difference between gold and silver coins.
- * Order Australian notes and coins by value.

Statistics and Probability

In Statistic and Probability, we are learning to:

- * Collect and organise data from our peers.
- * Make graphs using the data we have collect.

Inquiry— Weather in my World

Key understandings and knowledge our students will be developing this term in Inquiry are:

- * Identifying and recording the weather each day.
- * Learning about the Seasons
- * Learning about temperature
- * Learning about different types of weather, e.g. wind.

Water Bottle & Brain Food

It is important your child comes to school with a piece of fresh fruit and a water bottle everyday. This will help your child to grow and develop a healthy mind. Some suggestions include: an apple cut into pieces, banana, pear, carrot, celery, cucumber or cheese. All classes have a fruit break during the first 2 hours of the day.
